His first stage appearance came in 1976 when he appeared as the youngest VonTrapp child in a Winston-Salem, NC production of "The Sound of Music."

A graduate of North Forsyth High School and an alumnus of the Summer Enrichment Program and the North Carolina Governor's School, Jeffrey studied with William Beck and James Allbritten while pursuing a B.A. in opera performance at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts.

His resume includes theatre and concert performances across the United States as well as Germany, France, Austria, England and Wales.

Mr. Griffin's broadcast credits include work for CBS, ESPN, NASCAR, the PGA, the NBA, the Wall Street Journal and Focus on the Family.

A twenty-one year veteran of theatre, radio, film and television, Jeffrey Griffin is currently one of the premiere voice-over artists in the United States. His impressive recordings include work for Ford, Coca-Cola, FedEx, PBS, John Deere and McDonald's.

He has also served as the voice for NCAA championships, the National Cheerleading Championships and the US Olympic Committee.

Jeffrey has been the Voice of the Demon Deacons for Wake Forest University since 2001.

Mr. Griffin has performed as a keynote and motivational speaker for more than 250 organizations since 2000.

He is in constant demand as a voiceover artist, emcee, speaker, broadcaster and vocalist across the United States.

Big Jeffrey's first children's book, "The Princess Sophia," is set for publication in October, 2011 and his debut CD, "Daddy Songs," will be available in 2012.
